









Some Consequences of the Ecological Crisis

- Internal and external political tensions














The Cycle of Church Growth based on the 5 Marks of Mission





Joseph was a peasant farmer in Thyolo, Malawi. His life was in a mess, struggling with poverty, alcohol abuse & ancestral worship issues. He averaged just 7 bags of maize from his plot per year which was not even enough to care for his own family. He was without hope and aimless in his poor farming community when Johan van der Ham picked him out, along with several others, to disciple him in Farming God's Way. They met weekly over the preplanting season and with the opportunity of teaching Farming God's Way came the opportunity for Joseph to be discipled in the fulness of God's ways. He submitted his life to the Lordship of Christ, cleaned up his life and began to walk in faithfulness and good stewardship of the Farming God's Way tool he had been empowered with. At harvestime his yield was an astounding 70 bags - 10 times his average yield and the poverty cycle over his life was broken. Joseph now ministers full time with YWAM in Malawi.

This guide uses an internationally agreed method to asters sealend testainability to help you make the best sealend choices. It groups some of the most popularsealend species in Sugapore into 3 categories:



RECOMMENDED: From well-managed, sustainable stocks which are not considered to be over-exploited. These species are the preferred eating theire.



THINK TWICE: From fisheries that are at nisk of becaming unsustainable, due to management, environmental or stock issues. Only eat these species occasionally, if recommended options are not available.



ANDIO: Cansidered to be over-exploited, or from unsustainable, overfished and poorly managed fisheries. Avoid eating these species at present.

- Turn off the lights, TV and other equipment when I leave the room for more than (say) 30 minutes.


