How to make a Sack Garden

A Sack Garden is a small vegetable mound made from a nylon [or similar] sack.

What you need for a Sack Garden:

- Nylon or sisal sack
- A bottomless, empty can or pipe
- Fertile soil e.g. compost or top soil
- -Two long sticks
- Vegetable seeds and seedlings

Plant cabbage, onion or leafy vegetables on the side of the sack garden



Vegetables contain vitamins which protect our health

Stones give soil drainage and aeration

Sticks support the Sack Garden

Advantages

- Lots of vegetables
- In a small space
- All the year round
- next to your house

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Make the base

- Find an area near your house with sun and shade
- put some soil and compost at the bottom of the sack as a base
- put the bottomless can in the center



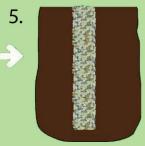
Fill the bottomless can with small stones.



Fill the sack around the can with soil and compost.



Lift the can up, put in on top of the stones and fill it with small stones again.



Repeat steps 2, 3 and 4 until the bag is full.



Drive the sticks into the ground next to the sack.
Plant seeds on top of it and seedlings on the sides.
